Introduction

Building climate action capacity in Local Authorities is acknowledged as being essential to support the leadership role in the fight against climate change and in building resilience to its negative effects. It is centred around equipping all Local Authority staff and elected members with the right resources to improve understanding, knowledge base and skills to enhance performance and increase capacity to drive effective and positive climate action in the work that they do.

The suite of training pillars identified in the short term under the Local Authority Climate Action Training Programme stems from an immediate requirement to develop climate action capacity to deliver adaptation strategies/plans and to begin to advance positive influence across all functions and activities performed by Local Authorities.

Other Climate Action training programmes continue to be designed and developed. Further details on these programmes, their target audiences and delivery dates will be circulated through further iterations of this document.

Target Learner

Actioning Policy consists of a number of targeted courses on particular focus areas for audiences from a range of Local Authority functions. These courses will aim to inform learners how they can ensure not just legislative and policy alignment with climate and environmental measures but also best practise. It is envisaged that the learners will be from a range of functions and activities across the Local Authority. During 2023, Actioning Policy training will continue to focus on the delivery of Green Public Procurement Training (GPP). Green Public Procurement training is comprised of three different strands:

Strand 1: Green Public Procurement Awareness Webinar (45 minute webinar) open to all indoor Local Authority Staff.

Strand 2: Implementing Green Public Procurement: A training programme for Local Authority staff engaged in the decision-making of the procurement of goods, services and works. To complete this training programme, you must have completed Strand 1 - Green Public Procurement Awareness Webinar.

Strand 3: Green Public Procurement Strategy: A training programme for Local Authority staff leading on and engaged in the development of a Green Procurement Strategy.

- Planning for Climate Change training (delivered during April/ May 2021) targeted at Local Authority planners of all disciplines.
