Introduction:

LASNTG has developed this half-day course for those who work in Banksman.

Aim of Programme:

The aim of this programme is to provide learners with Banksman skills enabling them to safely and efficiently give and receive directions to operators of construction plant and all other site traffic in accordance with the requirements of the relevant legislation and guidelines.

Target Learner:

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in Banksman skills. Learners can be Plant Operative, General Operative and all Outdoor.

Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Describe the Legislation relevant to the management of Plant/Site traffic
- Undertake a risk assessment for the safe direction of Plant/Site traffic on site in accordance with the requirements of the relevant legislation and guidelines
- Implement a Safe System of work on site when directing Plant/Site traffic around site and describe and identify the safety items required on plant (mirrors, cameras, reversing lights/beepers)
- Direct Plant/Site traffic safely around site using the correct hand signals to communicate with the driver
- Describe and implement safe methods of work for use in the vicinity of overhead cables

Assessment:

Site practical exams will be continuous throughout the programme.

The pass standard is 100% and will be achieved if the learner demonstrates the correct technique for each assessment point. The duration is 15 minutes for each learner.

Entry requirements:

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- Applicants must have reached the minimum requirement of a Valid Safe Pass Card or other appropriate Construction Safety Training.
- Previous Experience working on site is required.
- Good Vision and Hearing.

Equipment the learner must bring to the course:

- High Visibility, Safety Helmet and Boots.
