Aim of Programme:

To provide basic skills, knowledge and an overview for Local Authority personnel and others engaged in chlorine handling.

Target Learner:

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in Chlorine Handling. Learners can be a Plant Operative, General Operative, Technician, Engineer or Supervisor.

Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Demonstrate a knowledge of chlorine handling legislation, the importance of chlorine and how it works as a disinfection agent.
- Understand the forms and effects of chlorine as a disinfection agent and various efficiency techniques.
- Test for chlorine, maximise the efficiency of a disinfection process, calculate correct doses of chlorine and describe different sampling methods and equipment.
- Safely and efficiently handle chlorine.

Assessment:

There are current no assessments required to complete the course.

Entry requirements:

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- It is desirable that they have worked in, or are familiar with the operations of a water treatment plant.
