



Course Title: Commercial Vehicle Road Worthiness (7156)	
Duration: 1 Day	Certification: LASNTG Certification
Expiry Period: 5 Years	Award: Assessment Certificate

Aim of Programme:

This course forms part of the training requirements resulting from the RSA's Commercial Vehicle Road Worthiness requirements. It will create an awareness among the learners with regards to the legislation and guidelines in relation to their responsibilities in the use of vehicles for work purposes to include the following:

- Legalisation
- Vehicle Insurance
- Licence Categories
- Safe Driving
- Fuel Efficiency and reducing Co2 Emissions
- Trailers / Towing requirements and load security
- Maintenance checks and routines
- Attaching and securing loads / walk arounds inspection checks
- Record Keeping

Target Learner:

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in Commercial Vehicle Road Worthiness. Learners can be a Plant Operative or a member of Outdoor staff.

Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Describe the hazards associated with work vehicles used for transporting goods and the need to put preventative measures in place.
- Describe the legalisation standards and requirements when using a Van / Light Goods Vehicle LGV and the legal requirements when towing trailers.
- Understand and describe the legal requirements regarding vehicle insurance.
- Understand and describe the legal requirements regarding licence categories.
- Drive to RoSPA Standards.
- Understand how driving methods effect the fuel efficiency and Co2 production of the vehicle.
- Understand and describe the legal requirements when towing a trailer and how to secure any loads to be transported.
- Complete necessary records and ensure these are properly maintained.
- Carry out daily / weekly maintenance checks on vehicles and ensure faults are remedied and scheduled maintenance is undertaken.
- Safely and efficiently attach a trailer, secure a load, undertake walk around check and complete necessary record sheets.

Assessment:

The Learner must achieve a Pass Standard (70%) in the Theory Assessment. Referrals in the Theory Assessment will involve the Learner undertaking an alternate paper / assignment no less than 1 week and no greater than 1 month from the referral date. If the learner is referred on the second occasion the course will need to be resit again.



Entry requirements:

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- Must have full Driver Licence appropriate to vehicle.
