### **Aim of Programme:**

The aim of this programme is to train learners how to manage and enforce C&D Waste activities in accordance with current legislation and guidelines

#### **Target Learner:**

This training programme is for learners who must have experience in management, monitoring and/or regulation/enforcement of C&D waste activities. The primary target learner is Environmental Enforcement Staff; however, the course is also applicable to Engineers, Administrative Staff, Technicians, Scientists and Supervisory Grades.

## **Learning Outcomes:**

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Demonstrate an understanding of the framework of C& D waste policy in Ireland & EU.
- Demonstrate an in-depth knowledge of the regulation of waste, the various Agencies involved, sources of data, options for treating CDW and have appreciation of the waste hierarchy.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the legal responsibilities for waste management on sites and the fundamental principles of recycling and reuse.
- Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of site environmental awareness and how pollutants can travel on and offsite.
- Demonstrate an appreciation for the issues to be considered when inspecting, regulating & enforcing waste collection and waste management facilities and be aware of the legislative enforcement tools available to them.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the definition of By-Products and End of Waste Criteria and the processes involved to achieve these designations.

#### **Assessment:**

There is **Theory** based examination which is a Classroom Exam and Standard Pass is 70% and the duration is 20 minutes.

## **Entry requirements:**

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- Applicants must have a minimum of a Level 7 qualification.
- Learners must have experience in management, monitoring and/or regulation/enforcement of C&D waste activities.
