Introduction

- **Cork County** 12,000KM roads (12% of national road network)-climate, coastline etc
- 2023 DOT Funding- €72M R&L Roads
- CARO- Cork County Council Lead Authority in ASBS Region
- **RMO-** Cork County Council is the Lead Authority for the South-West Region in the Public Lighting Energy Efficiency Project
- 2020 DOT Funded Project- Cork Co Co & CARO Prioritisation Methodology for Climate Change Adaptation and Resilience Works

 Strongly Positioned to Lead Pilot Project on GPP & Carbon Reduction of Road Maintenance







Pilot Project Alignment with National Objectives

Memorandum on Grants for Regional & Local Roads



Identify optimum areas to introduce GPP

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




Work Package 2: GPP Guidance & Legislation Review

2023 RI Contract- To include 5% marks for 'Green Elements' (RAP/EMS etc)

2023 In- Situ Recycling Contract to double (8 roads)

Pilot Micro -surfacing contract in 2023






