



Course Title: Distribution System Operations and Maintenance (2082)

Aim of Programme:

To provide basic skills and knowledge for Local Authority personnel and others engaged in the operation and maintenance of the distribution system.

Target Learner:

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in Operations and Maintenance of Distribution Systems. Learners can be a General Operative, Technician, Engineer or Supervisor.

Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Demonstrate an understanding of the applicable legislation and regulations.
- Demonstrate an in-depth knowledge of the overall distribution system and the operation and maintenance of critical elements such as valves, pumps and reservoirs.
- Accurately identify quality problems in distribution systems and understand possible sources of contamination.
- Describe the processes for cleaning, scouring and disinfection of water mains and understand the correct operation of valves and hydrants.

Assessment:

There are currently no assessments required to complete this course.

Entry requirements:

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- It is desirable that they have worked in or are familiar with the operations of a water distribution system.
