Introduction:

LASNTG has developed this one-day course for those who work in the area of Drinking Water Regulations.

Aim of Programme:

To provide basic skills, knowledge and an overview for Local Authority personnel and others engaged in the monitoring of drinking water.

Target Learner:

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in monitoring of Drinking Water. Learners can be Plant Operative, General Operative, Technician, Engineer and Supervisor.

Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Demonstrate knowledge of the relevant drinking water standards, legislations and safety plans.
- Demonstrate knowledge of the important sections of the relevant legislations.
- Understand different investigations, notices and restrictions and correctly report to relevant bodies.
- Effectively deal with and report any complaints relating to drinking water and efficiently notify the relevant bodies.
- Efficiently and correctly deal with incidents / emergencies and effectively liaison with the relevant bodies.
- Demonstrate an understanding of how to deal with supplies and regulatory sample data.

Assessment:

There are currently no assessments required to complete this course.

Entry requirements:

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- It is desirable that they have worked in or are familiar with the operations of a water treatment plant.
