This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in monitoring of Drinking Water. Learners can be a Plant Operative, General Operative, Technician, Engineer or Supervisor.

- Demonstrate knowledge of the important sections of the relevant legislations.
- Understand different investigations, notices and restrictions and correctly report to relevant bodies.
- Effectively deal with and report any complaints relating to drinking water and efficiently notify the relevant bodies.
- Efficiently and correctly deal with incidents / emergencies and effectively liaison with the relevant bodies.
- Demonstrate an understanding of how to deal with supplies and regulatory sample data.

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
