**Aim of Programme:**

To provide basic skills and knowledge for Local Authority personnel and others engaged in the provision of drinking water supplies and the implementation of the 2007 Regulations.

**Target Learner:**

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in Drinking Water Supplies and the Implementation for the 2007 Regulations. Learners can be a Plant Operative, Technician, Engineer or Supervisor.

**Learning Outcomes:**

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Demonstrate knowledge of each handbook in general.
- Demonstrate knowledge of the 2007 drinking water regulations.
- Understand the procedure for the monitoring of drinking water quality.
- Provide Sampling Guidance.
- Provide analysis guidance.
- Demonstrate knowledge of what actions to take if a failure occurs.
- Take a syndicate exercise on action when failure.
- Correctly identify what specific actions must be taken when a failure occurs.
- Effectively deal with consumer complaints / incidents and emergencies as well as correctly carry out a report to the EPA.
- Correctly prepare drinking water safety plans.
- Demonstrate an in-depth knowledge of water treatment.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the distribution network, its operation and maintenance and its different components.
- Adequately prepare audit reports and efficiently respond to audit findings.

**Assessment:**

There are currently no assessments required to complete this course.

**Entry requirements:**

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- It is desirable if they have worked in or are familiar with the operations of a water treatment plant.
