# Aim of Programme:

The aim of this programme is to provide learners with the knowledge, skills, and expertise to collect, assemble and present evidence as part of their role as waste operatives. This will include but will not be limited to:

- To provide learners with the ability to operate within a legal framework and to carry out their work according to best practice standards.
- To provide learners with the ability to gather evidence that is admissible in any subsequent court hearing and that is compliant with the rules of evidence.
- To provide learners with the ability to analyse a case to determine what has to be proved and how to prove it.
- To provide learners with the ability to interview members of the public and document their findings in accordance with best practice standards.

# **Target Learner:**

The primary target learner is Waste Operatives; however, the course is also applicable to Waste Enforcement Officers, Litter / Community Wardens and Supervisory & Administrative Staff.

### Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to demonstrate knowledge of how waste management operatives need to collect and present evidence in the course of their work and to operate within a legal framework in accordance with best practice standards.
