Aim of Programme:

To provide basic skills and knowledge for Local Authority personnel and others on the process of evaluation, operation, and maintenance of filters.

Target Learner:

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in evaluation, operation and maintenance of filters. Learners can be a Plant Operative, General Operative, Technician, Engineer or Supervisor.

- Demonstrate an in-depth knowledge of the installation and function of mixed media filters.
- Accurately describe filter cleaning techniques and the criteria for media replacement.
- Describe accurately particle filters and different types of filtration.
