Aim of Programme:

To provide learners with the knowledge, skills and expertise in the following Fluoridation technology

- Fluoridation and the need to Fluoridate
- Legislative background
- Risk identification Drinking water safety
- Chemical Storage and Handling
- Operations and Maintenance
- Calculating dose and monitoring
- Troubleshooting

Target Learner:

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in Fluoridation Technology. Learners can be of all Grades: Plant Operative, Technician, Engineer or Plant Supervisor.

Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Demonstrate knowledge of fluoridation and the legislation governing it.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the DWSP approach and identify / deal with the risks associated with fluoride storage.
- Safely and efficiently manage the fluoridation process on site.
- Calculate the correct fluoride chemical dose and collect, review and present monitoring data.

Assessment:

There is a Multiple Choice in Drinking Water Fluoridation with a Pass Standard of 70% and a duration of 1 hour to complete.

Entry requirements:

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- Applicants must have reached the minimum requirement of a valid safe pass card.
- Learner must have an awareness of operation of a drinking water treatment plant.
- Learner must have good colour vision.
