Aim of Programme:

To provide basic skills, knowledge and an overview for Local Authority personnel and others engaged in Drinking Water Supply Hygiene.

Target Learner:

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in Drinking Water Supply Hygiene. Learners can be a Plant Operative, General Operative, Technician, Engineer or Supervisor.

Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Demonstrate knowledge of the necessity for hygiene in water services and good housekeeping techniques.
- Demonstrate an understanding of good hygiene practices for personnel, vehicles, chemicals, materials and fittings.
- Demonstrate an in-depth knowledge of catchment protection.
- Understand the importance of proper water treatment and the monitoring of this treatment.
- Demonstrate knowledge of service reservoirs and water towers.
- Demonstrate knowledge of procedures around the distribution network and carry out the correct procedure for contamination incidents.
- Accurately explain the installation procedure for new fittings, new mains and the procedure for repairing existing fittings.

Assessment:

There are currently no assessments required to complete this course.

Entry requirements:

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- It is desirable that they have worked in or are familiar with the operations of a water treatment plant.
