Aim of Programme:

To provide basic skills, knowledge and an overview for Local Authority personnel and others engaged in the process of nutrient removal.

Target Learner:

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in nutrient removal. Learners can be a Plant Operative, General Operative, Technician, Engineer or Supervisor.

- Accurately explain the processes surrounding phosphorous removal.
