

Course Title: Operation and Maintenance of Lawnmowers (2104)

Aim of Programme:

The aim of this programme is to provide learners with the necessary knowledge and skills to allow them to operate and maintain a Lawn Mower safely and efficiently.

Target Learner:

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in operation and maintenance of Lawnmowers. Learners can be a General Operative, Outdoor Staff or a Supervisor.

Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Describe the regulations and safety requirements relevant to the operation of Lawn Mowers.
- Describe the characteristics and operation of the common types of cutting, discharge and collection mechanisms.
- Safely and efficiently carry out pre-start, daily, weekly and periodic checks and maintenance of the Lawn Mower.
- Safely and efficiently set-up, adjust and operate the Lawn Mower.

Assessment:

There is a **Theory** based examination which is a Classroom Exam and Standard Pass is 70% and the duration is 20 minutes.

Also, a **Skills** demonstration with is a Site Practical Exam and has Standard Pass of 100% and this duration is 30 minutes.

Entry requirements:

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- Must have successfully completed Safe Pass.
- Previous experience in working with plant and machinery is desirable and working on roads/adjacent to roads.
- Good colour vision and hearing.

Equipment the learner must bring to course:

• PPE – eye protection, overalls, ear defenders, hi-vis jacket/vest, safety boots, gloves
