Aim of Programme:

The aim of this programme is to provide basic skills and knowledge for Local Authority personnel and others on the operation and maintenance of small-scale wastewater treatment plants.

Target Learner:

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience on the operation and maintenance of small-scale wastewater treatment plants. Learners can be a Plant Operative, General Operative, Technician, Engineer or Supervisor.

Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Demonstrate an in depth knowledge of the functions of relevant pieces of plant.
- Correctly operate and maintain the plant in Unit 1, deal with plant problems encountered and adequately prepare for onsite inspections.

Assessment:

There are currently no assessments required to complete this course.

Entry requirements:

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- It is desirable that they have worked in or are familiar with the operations of a wastewater treatment plant
