Who should apply for this programme?

These programmes are open to those already working in the water industry and are looking to enhance their management and planning skills within the sector. It will be of particular interest to professionals looking to broaden their experience and qualifications and perhaps move into the water services sphere. The Postgraduate Diploma will see learners complete the modules listed above over two years. On completion of these two years, students can complete an additional year consisting a research dissertation relevant to the individual or their employer. Successful completion of this third year will lead to the award of Master of Science.

How will I learn?

ATU Sligo have extensive experience successfully delivering on-line learning for a range of disciplines, industries and professions. It is targeted at those have existing life and working commitments. Professional students seeking to upskill or refresh their qualifications can learn online from anywhere at a time that suits them. This programme is delivered part-time, utilising a blended, on-line lecture and workshop mode of delivery over 2/3 years of learning. Two on-site workshops per taught semester forms part of the programme. Lectures are delivered live online and recorded for playback at any time.

Entry Requirements

Second class honours (2.2) Level 8 degree in Engineering, Science or a cognate professional area or equivalent is required for entry to this programme.
