



Course Title: Pipeline Corrosion / Lead Services (7040)

Aim of Programme:

The aim of this programme is to provide basic skills and knowledge for Local Authority personnel of the causes of pipeline corrosion, including lead, copper and iron, and an overview of the appropriate preventative measures.

Target Learner:

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in pipeline corrosion, including lead, copper and iron, and an overview of the appropriate preventative measures. Learners can be a Plant Operative, Technician or Engineer.

Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Demonstrate an understanding of corrosion and the different types.
- Describe correctly how to protect pipelines from different types of corrosion.
- Demonstrate knowledge of the operation and maintenance of pumps.
- Describe correctly rehabilitating and replacing lead piping.
- Demonstrate knowledge of relevant lead replacement projects.

Assessment:

There are currently no assessments required to complete this course.

Entry requirements:

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- It is desirable that they have worked in or are familiar with the operations of a water treatment plant
