Aim of Programme:

To prepare, inform and equip relevant local authority employees to respond appropriately to the various stages of a Serious Incident scenario.

Target Learner:

This training programme is to train the participant on how to respond to a Serious Incident Scenario. Learners can be area based supervisory grade local authority personnel including H & S Officers, Director of Services, Line Managers, Engineers, Technicians or Staff Welfare Officers.

- Understand the legislative context which is applicable to the management of Serious Incident scenarios.
- Understand their roles and responsibilities should a Serious Incident arise in their workplace.

Assessment:

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- Previous knowledge and experience of dealing with workplace accidents and incidents is desirable. Knowledge of the local authority's serious accident/incident procedures and the relevant parts of the safety management system is desirable.
