



<b>Course Title: Road Opening and Reinstatement – Basic (7218)</b>	
<b>Duration: 2 Days</b>	<b>Certification: LASNTG Certification</b>

**Introduction:**

LASNTG has developed this two-day course for those who work in Road Opening and Reinstatement - Basic.

**Aim of Programme:**

The aim of this programme is to provide the participants with the required knowledge, skills and expertise to carry out opening, back filling and reinstatement in public roads to the standards set out by the Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport Guidelines for Managing Opening in Public Roads.

**Target Learner:**

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in Road Opening and Reinstatement Basic. Learners can be General Operative, Technician, Engineer and Supervisor.

**Learning Outcomes:**

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Demonstrate an understanding of the Map Road Licensing System, Notifications and License Types and the License Process
- Demonstrate an understanding of and describe the various methods of road construction in Ireland.
- Properly trim back and edge a trench at excavation and reinstatement stage for various road and footway surfaces.
- Understand how to properly reinstate a modular pavement
- Determine the suitability of back fill material and use in accordance with the requirements.
- Determine the appropriate compaction equipment and correct lift thickness for the common back fill materials, select the appropriate number of passes.
- Select the correct compaction equipment for common materials and tasks.
- Carry out testing of ground conditions at base level and carry out compaction of back fill materials.
- Construct the various temporary and permanent running surfaces required on roads and footways and properly seal all joints in accordance with the guidelines.
- Keep appropriate records for the trench reinstatements to enable sign off by the approved certifier and inspection by relevant authorities.
- Identify defects, know the allowable tolerances and know how to carry out remedial actions.

**Assessment:**

There is a **Theory** based examination which is a Classroom Exam and Standard Pass is 70% and the duration is 40 minutes.

Also, two **Skills** demonstration with is Site Practical Exam and has Standard Pass of 100% for each and this total duration is 2 hours.
