Aim of Programme:

The aim of this programme is to provide participants with the required knowledge, skills and expertise to carry out road surface repair and maintenance in accordance with the relevant guidance.

Target Learner:

This training programme is for learners who will have worked or have experience in undertaking road surface repair and maintenance. Learners can be General Operative, Supervisor and an outdoor member of staff.

Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Describe how roads are constructed, identify the common types of road surface defect and demonstrate an understanding of how these defects should be repaired.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the three basic types of road repair and display a knowledge of the materials and plant used in each process.
- Outline the correct health and safety procedures to be carried out before, during and after road repair and maintenance work.
- Demonstrate knowledge of the correct methodology for carrying out road surface repairs.

Assessment:

There are currently no assessments required to complete this course.

Entry requirements:

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- Applicants must have reached the minimum requirement of a Valid Safe Pass Card.
- it is desirable that participants have worked in, or are familiar with Road Construction
