### **Aim of Programme:**

The aim of this programme is to ensure Local Authority personnel and others working on roads have received the necessary training required to complete a safe system work plan and associated activities.

### **Target Learner:**

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in safe system work plan and associated activities. Learners can be a General Operative, Technician, Engineer or Supervisor.

### **Learning Outcomes:**

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Demonstrate an understanding of the background to safe systems of work plans and the relevant sections of the applicable legislations.
- Define and identify hazards and risks and come up with control measures to minimise them.
- Demonstrate an in-depth knowledge of risk assessments and their practical application.
- List the reasons for SSWPs and be able to outline the procedure involved in an SSWP.
- Give correct examples of different types of SSWPs.

### **Assessment:**

There is a **Theory** based examination which is a Classroom Exam and Standard Pass is 70% and the duration is 40 minutes.

### **Entry requirements:**

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- It is desirable if participants have worked or are familiar with Road Construction.
