Aim of Programme:

The aim of this programme is to provide learners with required knowledge, skills and expertise to carry out the role of school warden in a safe and efficient manner in accordance with the relevant Health and Safety regulations.

Target Learner:

This training programme is for learners who will have worked with or have experience in the role of a School Warden. Learners can only be School Wardens.

Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Demonstrate an in-depth knowledge of the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Act and Health and Safety Regulations.
- Demonstrate knowledge of the applicable policies and know how to deal with pedestrian problems.
- Deal with single / dual lanes and different types of crossings and correctly judge the distances and speeds of vehicles.
- Perform the correct on-site checks and correctly manage any conflict that may arise.
- Understand the correct procedure involved in signalling traffic and beckoning pedestrians.
