Aim of Programme:

The aim of this programme is to train the learner to operate the chipping distributor to

- Deliver the correct rate of spread in accordance with the design, safely and efficiently,
- To correctly maintain the chipping spreader,
- Complete relevant construction site tests,
- Complete necessary construction records.

Target Learner:

This training programme is for learners who have previous experience as part of a surface dressing construction team. Learners can be Plant Operative, Supervisor, Technician or Engineer Grade.

Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this programme, the learner will be able to:

- Understand the many factors that effect the design and success of a surface dressing job.
- Understand and check the plant pieces and settings that effect surface dressing.
- Know how to set-up and operate the chipping spreader controls during surface dressing.
- Undertake the role of the chipping spreader operator as part of a surface dressing crew.
- Understand the factors that effect safety and health and follow safe operating procedures.
- Identify and explain the various parts of the chipping spreader.

Assessment:

There is **Theory** based examination which is a Classroom Exam and Standard Pass is 70% and the total duration is 10 minutes.

Also, **Skills** demonstration with is Site Practical Exam and has Standard Pass of 70% and this duration is 5 minutes.

Entry requirements:

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- Applicants must have reached the minimum requirement of a Valid Safe Pass Card or other Appropriate Construction Safety Training, basic surface dressing.
- Learners must have previous experience as part of a surface dressing construction team.

Equipment the learner must bring to the course:

 High viz jackets, safety boots and other items listed in the employers safety statement/ method statements.
