There is **Theory** based examination which is a Classroom Exam and Standard Pass is 80% and the total duration is 15 minutes.

Also, a **Skills** demonstration with is Site Practical Exam and has Standard Pass of 100% and this total duration is 1 hour.

Entry requirements:

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate a level of knowledge, skill and competence associated with Level 4 of the NFQ.
- Must hold a valid Safe Pass card
- Previous experience working on roadworks is desirable
